Reeg named head of MasterCard's O'Fallon operation

MasterCard Worldwide has named Rob Reeg as president of MasterCard Global Technology and Operations, based in O'Fallon. Reeg has held that position on an interim basis since January.

Reeg succeeds W. Roy Dunbar who resigned in January to head another company.

Reeg, 52, has worked for MasterCard for the past 13 years. He was named the company's chief technology officer in 2005 and was responsible for computer operations, network engineering, technology architecture, database management, program management, information security and software testing and quality. Before joining MasterCard, he worked for Sprint Corp., Cleveland Pneumatic, Totco Inc. and Conoco Inc.

MasterCard's GTO headquarters in O'Fallon manages its operations in 210 countries and territories. The company said that last year its network processed 18.7 billion transactions with a gross dollar volume of \$2.3 trillion.
